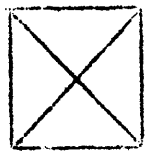

MARTINSON FOR GRADUATE REP-AT-LARGE

Bob Martinson is a graduate student, in the Dept. of Sociology. He has been fighting vigorously for student democracy and academic freedom for many years and, as his past record shows, cannot be swayed by hysteria or pressure from defending basic student rights.

As the Berkeley chairman of the Socialist Youth League, Martinson has been a frequent student speaker on, and active opponent of war, militarism, racial prejudice and the reactionary attacks on civil liberties which have been sweeping the country.

Martinson is a democratic socialist. Here is his program:

REVIVE CAMPUS DEMOCRACY

1. REVOKE THE OATH. Continue the struggle for academic freedom.
2. ABOLISH RULE 17. To help preserve and extend academic freedom; diverse student groups should be allowed on campus.
3. FOR THE RIGHT TO VOTE. Over 30 per cent of the students are disenfranchised by the ASUC card poll-tax since they cannot afford \$12.50 a year. The right to vote should be automatic, while a voluntary athletics card should be offered for those who can afford it.
4. EXPAND THE EX-COMMITTEE. How can ten people adequately represent over 18,000 students?
5. FOR STUDENT GOVERNMENT. Give the non-student reps (3 out of 13) on Ex-Committee voice but no vote.
6. NO SECOND CLASS CITIZENS. Give graduate students equal right with undergraduates to run for ASUC offices.
7. ABOLISH COMPULSORY ROTC. Let the student choose whether he takes RO or not.
