

RESOLUTIONS OF Y.C.L. CONFERENCE

Resolution of National Conference of the Y.C.L. of the U.S.A. on the Sixth World Congress of the Young Communist International. This page is open to our readers' discussions.

1. The National Conference of the Young Communist League, U. S. A., after due study and deliberation upon the resolutions and reports of the 6th World Congress of the Young Communist International, declares its full agreement with the decisions of this historical Congress.

2. The 6th Y.C.I. Congress fully associated itself with the decisions of the 7th Congress of the Communist International. Basing itself on the findings and teachings of this Congress, the Y.C.I. Congress further analyzed the plight of the young toiling generation of the capitalist world, the rich experiences and lessons of the revolutionary youth movement, and pointed the path to the unification of the forces of the toiling youth against fascism and war and for Socialism.

POPULARIZE DECISIONS

This conference undertakes, as one of its most important tasks, to popularize the decisions of these two world congresses to the widest masses of youth and first of all to the members of the Y.C.L. The decisions of the 6th Y.C.I. Congress have a great significance for the youth of America and for our Y.C.L. The Congress shows us the general path

that we will activate our membership and carry through correct mass work in the trade unions, in the shops, among the unemployed youth, among the Negro youth, in the schools and mass organizations of the youth.
