

500 PEOPLE CROWDED A RAY AT BRANCH FOUR'S DEBATE

Comrade Duffy, Socialist Garment Worker, "Puts it Over" Lawyer Thayer "Like a Tent," Proving That Theodore Roosevelt is a Dangerous Enemy of the Working Class.

Over 500 people were able to pack into Colonel Hall last Sunday to hear the debate between Wallace Thayer, Bull Moose lawyer, and William E. Duffy, Socialist garment worker.

About a third of the audience were avowed Bull Moores, who had come to see the representative of the working class get a "trimming" at the hands of the well-known lawyer.

Although suffering from severe hoarseness, having been speaking constantly on street-corners since July 1st, Duffy delivered, with telling effect, the indictment of the working class against the big Bull Moose.

TUBERCULOSIS HOSPITAL GETS ANOTHER DELAY

Politicians Want to Build Administration Building First, Then Maybe in Three Years Put Up Building for Patients — In the Meantime, Victims Die in Poverty and Neglect.

Keen disappointment and indignation among the social workers, physicians, citizens and tuberculosis sufferers, from the decision of the Municipal Hospital Commission that no work will be attended toward the erection of a tuberculosis pavilion on the West Farm site for at least three years.

Whether or not the board of supervisors enlarges the almshouse hospital to accommodate more tuberculosis patients, will not alter the situation materially. No decent, self-respecting citizen will consent to the stigma of pauperism which attaches itself to all who enter the almshouse hospital.

Since January 1st of this year, 1040 new cases of tuberculosis, three-fourths of them are advanced, have been reported to the local Dept. of Health.

As Socialists, we regard the tuberculosis problem as an economic one, which will disappear only with the abolition of capitalism.

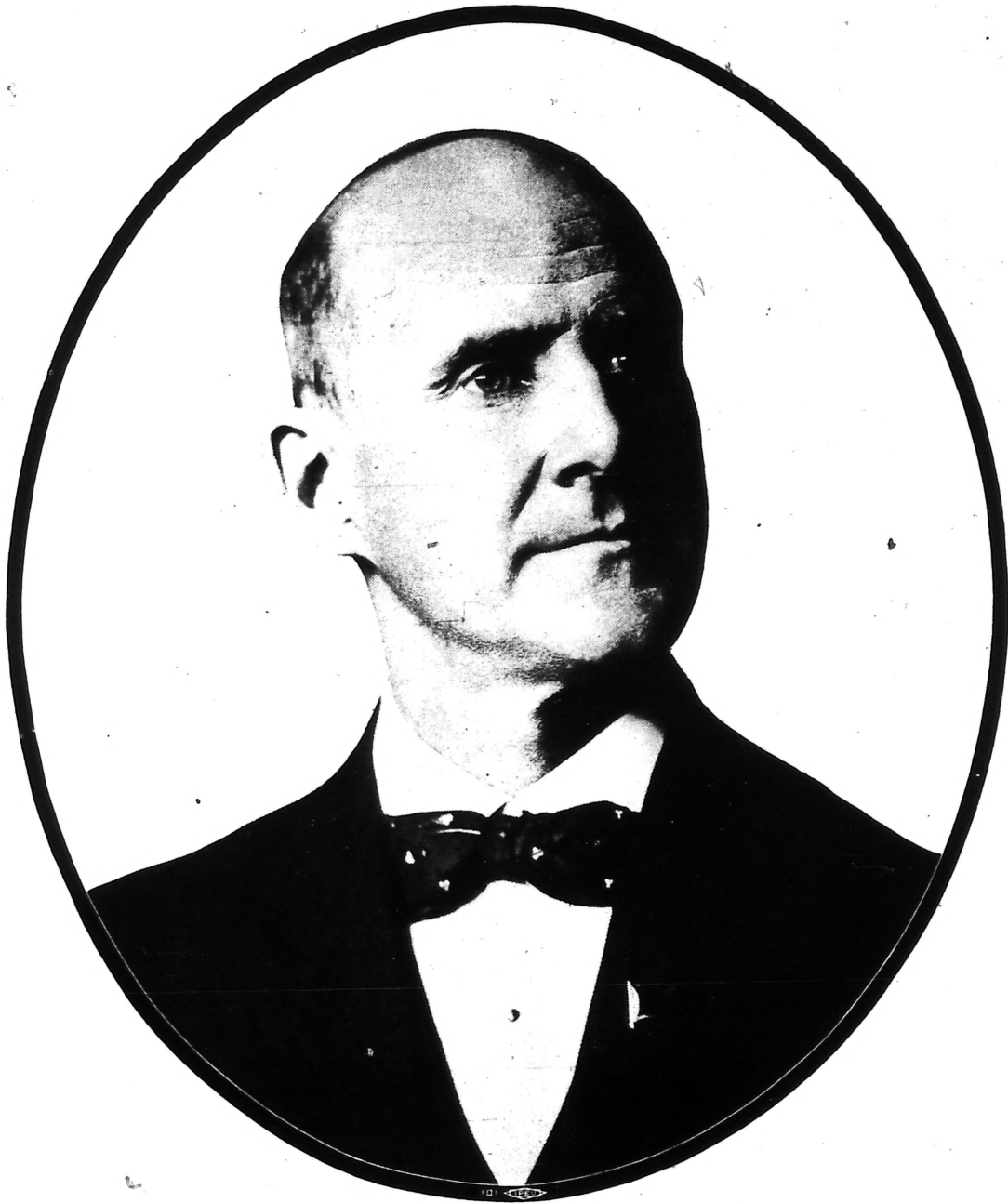
