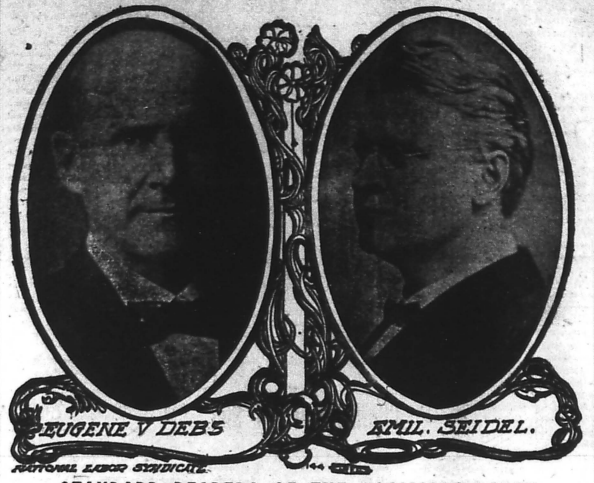
COME TO THE BROADWAY ARSENAL ELECTION NIGHT
