For one life, \$1,500.
For one leg, or one arm, \$500.
For one eye, \$250.
For maimed hand, left, \$250; right, \$500.
For one finger, \$50 to \$100.

According to Wages

The committee reported that \$1,500, the amount scheduled for one life, was about the average of three years' wages of a miner.
