Since capitalism is founded on the exploitation of the labor for the enrichment of the idle parasites, for the aggrandizement of the dominant class, on the division of wealth by every man for the benefit of a few, which would eliminate profits and robbery, it is antagonistic to the innate right of every man to enjoy the product of his own labor and for these reasons it is opposed by the disciples of Karl Marx.

In the philosophy of the master class and its pressure the trade-unionist who is not a Socialism is not a Socialism... who it is, and the worker who is neither one nor the other but can assign himself to the state of slavery in which he was born, is not practical at all.

The public at large don't notice it, especially people who don't take more than two or three newspapers, but it's not negligible to get a big impression on the public... to get the public's attention at a session.
