"Other facts collected in this investigation show conclusively that a very large proportion of the families did not live in decency and comfort. Thirty per cent kept boarders and lodgers, a condition repugnant to every ideal of American family life, especially in the crowded tenements or tiny cottages in which the wage earners of America characteristically live. Furthermore, in 77 per cent of the families 2 or more persons occupied each sleeping room, in 37 per cent 3 or more persons, and in 1 per cent 4 or more persons."
