Hilton Will Contest Disbarment in Utah

Attorney for Hillstrom Declares He Will Retract Nothing He Said Concerning Supreme Court's Acts.

(Rocky Mountain News, Denver) Judge O. N. Hilton, served with disbarment papers by the Utah Supreme Court... He declared emphatically that he was ready to show that Joseph Hillstrom, secretary of the union...
