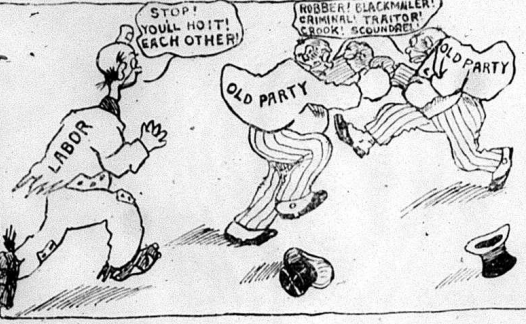
As was to be expected, the open revolutionary advance of the proletariat called forth a movement of the political opposition all along the line.

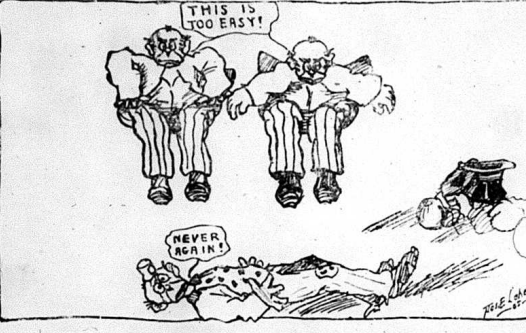
