

WHO MISLED THE CANTON
RED GUARDS?

[Following is a translation of an article originally entitled "Who Misled the Canton MAO Tse-tung-ism Red Guards?" by the MAO Tse-tung's Thought Group of the Kwangtung Provincial Tung-fang-hung Schools Revolutionary Alliance Red Guards in the Chinese-language newspaper Hung-ch'i Pao (Red Flag News), No 39, 10 Sep 67, Canton, pp 3-4, published by its own editorial department, South China Engineering Institute, Criticizing T'AO Joint Committee of the Canton Third Headquarters.]

Editor's note: The Canton MAO Tse-tung-ism Red Guards (Chu-i-ping) have for a long time faithfully served as fighters for the handful of Party persons in Canton taking the capitalist road and opposed the rebels in every way. Especially today when the Party persons taking the capitalist road are suffering a political defeat, Chu-i-ping under the instruction of the handful Party persons taking the capitalist road are energetically waging an armed struggle in an attempt to reverse their doomed fate. Chu-i-ping have gone completely to the opposite side.

How have Chu-i-ping gone to the opposite side? Where did the black hand misleading Chu-i-ping come from? This is a problem concerning every revolutionary. Therefore, we have published the long article "Who Misled the Canton MAO Tse-tung-ism Red Guards?" by the MAO Tse-tung's Thought Group of the Provincial Tung-fang-hung Schools' (Hua-shih Affiliated Middle School) Revolutionary Alliance Red Guards. In this article they started from their own angle of view and exposed how the handful of Party persons taking the capitalist road in Canton supported and controlled Chu-i-ping on the basis of their own understanding and experience. This article is significant

in our recognition of the ugly faces of the handful of Party persons taking the capitalist road in Canton and in aiding the deceived Chu-i-ping in recognizing their own mistakes.

PREFACE

The Canton Chu-i-ping have long become a royal tool of the handful of persons taking the capitalist road in the Party, the government, and the army. They have gone over to the opposite side. Who led Chu-i-ping astray? Traced to the origin, it was T'AO Chu (7118/6999) and his despicable agents in the Party and the army in Canton, CHAO Tzu-yang (6392/4793/7122), HUANG Yung-sheng (7806/3057/0524) and company. Let us raise the curtains of history and see how the handful of persons in the Party and the army in Canton colluded with each other in leading Chu-i-ping astray.

I

In September of last year, Chu-i-ping of the city's middle schools expressed the desire for alliance. The handful of persons taking the capitalist road immediately supported the idea, plotting to control Chu-i-ping. They instigated their children to control the leadership of the preparatory committee. At that time, the real power holders of the headquarters included: YANG Ch'iu-yuan (2799/6726/0337), son of the Canton Military District Deputy Commander YANG Mei-sheng (2799/2734/3932); HUANG Ch'un-ming (7806/2504/2494), son of the Canton Military District Commander HUANG Yung-sheng; CHAN Ho-p'ing (6124/0735/1627), son of the Canton Military District Deputy Commander CHAN Ts'ai-fang (6124/2088/5364); PAI Shao-hua (4101/1421/5478), son of the leader of the Ch'un-lei group, PAI Yu-li (4101/3768/4409); TSENG K'o-nan (2582/0344/0589), daughter of the three-anti TSENG Sheng (2582/3932); WANG Chi-ou (3769/4949/2962), daughter of the traitor WANG Te-chih (3769/1795/0037). Additionally, they sent people to participate in various meetings of the preparatory committee and drew up action outlines and organizational plans for Chu-i-ping. The Canton Military District also took part in this, and CHAN Ts'ai-fang proposed three conditions at the Chu-i-ping meeting: good status (from families of laborers), good political ideology, and good organizational discipline. The origin of all these was T'AO Chu. These insidious conspirators were very busy working for the establishment of the headquarters.

On the day of the establishment of the provisional headquarters, besides the attendance of all the important persons of the provincial and municipal committees and the Central South Bureau, we shall never

forget the representatives of the Canton Military District KUO Ch'eng-
shu (6753/2052 /2691) and CH'EN Te (7115/1795). They were bright-faced
and wearing the arm-bands of Chu-i-ping, unanimously supporting Chu-i-
ping. CHAN Ts'ai-fang also became an advisor to Chu-i-ping. Thus in
the midst of thunderous applauses and shouts, on the day of the
establishment of the headquarters, Chu-i-ping were quietly led on to
the tracks paved by the handful of persons in the Party and the army
taking the capitalist road.

In order to make Chu-i-ping completely their royal tool, the
handful of persons in the Party and the army taking the capitalist road
politically and economically dissolved and corroded Chu-i-ping under
the banner of supporting the young revolutionary rebels. They sold the
reactionary theory of blood relations to Chu-i-ping and encouraged them
to oppress people, making Chu-i-ping believe that they were of noble
blood. They blew the evil wind of economism towards the headquarters;
large sums of money, motorcycles, bicycles, and train tickets -- they
had them all. Chu-i-ping printed leaflets suppressing mass revolt and
censuring rebels in other areas totaling 50,000-100,000 copies -- or
any amount they wanted.

It was said that to control the Chu-i-ping of "Pa I" Middle
School, T'AO Chu telephoned HUANG Yung-sheng twice. Now it is clear
that HUANG Yung-sheng controlled not only "Pa I" Middle School Chu-i-
ping but also the entire city's Chu-i-ping. Faithfully carrying out
T'AO Chu's orders, HUANG Yung-sheng is really T'AO's worthy disciple.

II

Despite the attack of the evil wind of economism and the theory of
blood relations, the broad Chu-i-ping warriors still possessed the
strong desire for revolution. At the end of September, the Kwangtung
Provincial Tung-fang-hung Schools' Revolutionary Chu-i-ping wrote the
revolutionary leaflet "Bombard WANG Lan-hsi (3769/7061/6007), Fiercely
Expose CH'U Meng-chueh (0575/1125/6030)" and this leaflet won the
support of the revolutionary Chu-i-ping. To coordinate with the dis-
tribution of the leaflets, the original plan called for a Chu-i-ping
meeting in the SUN Yat-sen Memorial Hall, to bombard the provincial and
municipal committees and to raise a new high tide of revolution in
Canton. All revolutionary Chu-i-ping were overjoyed and eager. CHAO
Tzu-yang and company were frightened and used all schemes to attack
this plan of revolutionary action.

First, they reversed their usual attitude and tried to obstruct
the printing of the leaflets. On 29 September when we took the

preliminary draft to the Canton Municipal Committee, they refused it by saying "How can a leaflet opposing the Central Committee members be printed." Such unreasonableness angered Chu-i-ping. A number of the Kwangtung Provincial Tung-fang-hung schools assailed the Municipal Committee and solemnly announced that if it was not printed, they would mobilize the city's Chu-i-ping to handwrite it, the guards assigned to maintain order at the National Day rally would refuse to attend, and moreover they would hold a mass meeting of bombardment. This scared the masters and they reluctantly agreed to print it.

However, CHAO Tzu-yang and company would not give up and hastily asked master T'AO for instruction, attempting to use "the number four person" to suppress Chu-i-ping. This old thief T'AO Chu was quite worried upon hearing the news. How could his position be secure without putting out such fierce fire. On 4 October, T'AO Chu issued this black directive to the Provincial Committee and Central South Bureau: "The problem of the Kwangtung Provincial Tung-fang-hung schools must be resolved internally and must not be allowed to spread, nor become complicated to involve the society." At the same time, similar phone calls also reached the home of HUANG Yung-sheng. Needless to say, the handful of persons in the provincial and municipal committees and the Central South Bureau taking the capitalist road did their utmost in faithfully carrying out their master's instructions with threats and enticements. What was HUANG Yung-sheng's attitude towards this serious political problem? Chairman MAO has instructed us: "Whoever stands on the side of the revolutionary people is revolutionary; whoever stands on the side of imperialism, feudalism, and bureaucratic capitalism is counter-revolutionary." At this crucial moment, into what direction did HUANG Yung-sheng lead Chu-i-ping? Was it resolute support for this revolutionary action to open fire on the handful of Party persons taking the capitalist road? Or was it obstructing this revolutionary action and leading them astray, in order to protect the handful of Party persons taking the capitalist road?

Iron facts cannot be denied; HUANG Yung-sheng regarded T'AO Chu's black directive as God's will and did his best to win over Chu-i-ping.

In the morning of 4 October T'AO Chu called HUANG Yung-sheng. HUANG knew that Kwangtung Provincial Tung-fang-hung Schools' Chu-i-ping were about to take action. Late at night on 4 October HUANG first called the parents of two of the 11 students telling them to persuade their children not to distribute the leaflets. Later, he called the leaders of the headquarters of preparing to coordinate with Kwangtung Provincial Tung-fang-hung Schools' Chu-i-ping actions HUANG Ch'un-ming and CHAN Ho-p'ing to his home. He ordered them not to take part in this and forbade the headquarters to be involved. The handful of bad leaders of the headquarters placed their own interest and that of their

master above the cause of revolution, meekly followed their master's words, and spent hundreds of dollars for incitations, thus selling out the broad Chu-i-ping. At this time, HUANG Yung-sheng was overjoyed that without the support of the headquarters they were isolated. On the following day (5 October), HUANG Yung-sheng devoted all his energy to taking care of young warriors of Kwangtung Provincial Tung-fang-hung schools. He personally called a meeting of parents of the children of military and cadre families among the 11 persons, and exerted pressure on them. At three o'clock in the afternoon he ordered CHAN Ts'ai-fang and others to talk to the children of the military and cadres under fancy pretexts of "general parents" and "Trade Fair Protectors," trying all methods to stop them from distributing the revolutionary leaflets. HUANG Yung-sheng and company completely ignored the "16 articles" but faithfully carried out T'AO's directive. When the 11 people proposed to request instructions from the Central Cultural Revolution Group and to contact Comrade CHIANG Ch'ing, HUANG Yung-sheng and company were in a grave predicament. Finally, they mumbled: "No need to! Comrade T'AO Chu has spoken." Their meaning is that T'AO Chu represented the Party Central Committee. Isn't it clear on which side HUANG Yung-sheng and company stand?

In the scheme of suppressing and winning over Chu-i-ping, HUANG Yung-sheng and company produced an effect that the handful of Party persons in Canton taking the capitalist road failed to produce. Because of the suppression by HUANG Yung-sheng and company in cahoots with CHAO Tzu-yang and company and the selling out of Chu-i-ping by the handful of the leaders, the fire of the large-scale mass movement was put out.

III

After October of last year, when the struggle between the two roads was getting very fierce, the Chu-i-ping headquarters was completely paralyzed, and the fragmented command posts were still controlled by the Municipal Committee. At this time, Chu-i-ping already represented the conservative force. Chu-i-ping, however, rapidly became fragmented in the ferocious class struggle.

A number of Chu-i-ping of Kwangtung Provincial Tung-fang-hung schools insisted on waging a struggle against the handful of Party persons taking the capitalist road. Although they constituted only a minority of Chu-i-ping, truth was on their side. HUANG Yung-sheng and company regarded these revolutionary young rebels as thorns in the side and continued to impose various political oppressions on this minority of revolutionary Chu-i-ping. In December of last year, when they

were preparing to energetically bombard T'AO Chu, Provincial Committee member LIN Li-ming (2651/2621/2494), at the meeting of the Party Committee of the Canton Military District, announced: Kwangtung Provincial Tung-fang-hung Schools' Chu-i-ping were conservative (referring to the minority). Subsequently, under the pretense of searching for Allied Action elements, the police department dispatched fully armed personnel to search their residences. After the so-called 28 January and 8 February incidents of smashing the Military District Headquarters, these Red Guards wrote the poster, "Insist on the general revolutionary direction of the rebels in the Army." HUANG Yung-sheng and company of the Canton Military District resorted to the base means of spying on them, taking pictures of the posters and sending spies to watch their revolutionary activities.

The Chu-i-ping represented by YANG Ch'iu-yuan, HUANG Ch'un-ming, CHAN Ho-p'ing, and CHENG Tung-yang (6774/2639/7122) led an easy life, and became corrupt politically. They surrounded the rebels at the gate of the Municipal Committee, and spearheaded the attack on the Hung-ch'i Pao, thus completely opposing the revolutionary rebels and protecting the handful of Party persons taking the capitalist road. They kept a close relationship with the infamous Peking Allied Action group and followed its example in slandering and cursing Comrade CHIANG Ch'ing (3068/7230) at the gate of the Military District headquarters and directly bombarding the Central Cultural Revolution Group. HUANG Yung-sheng accorded all kinds of conveniences to this group of conservative Chu-i-ping taking the dangerous road. A handful of Chu-i-ping rioted, and looted, stole cars and seriously disrupted the order of the society, while the security headquarters pretended knowing nothing. Those who went to "Pa I" Middle School to arrest Allied Action elements were merely engaged in sham actions in order to let them escape. Allied Action members were frequent guests at the homes of many commanders of the Canton and Kwangtung Military District. The leader of Allied Action, P'ENG Hsiao-merg (1756/1420/5536) once lived in HUANG Yung-sheng's house. They were treated as guests and untouched. HUANG Yung-sheng was playing the game of putting on the false front of arresting Allied Action elements. What is it if it is not a big joke?

HUANG Yung-sheng and company hate the young revolutionaries while respecting T'AO Chu, CHAO Tzu-yang and company: they hate the revolutionary Chu-i-ping while respecting the handful of Chu-i-ping in cahoots with the Allied Action elements. Isn't their hypocritic mask clear to everyone? An editorial of Chieh-fang-chun Pao (Liberation Army News) points out: Under the new situation of the current great Proletarian Cultural Revolution, the People's Liberation Army has to be involved the question is not involvement or no involvement; it is on which side one stands, to support the proletarian revolutionaries, or to support the conservatives or even the Right. HUANG Yung-sheng and company of the Canton Military District did get involved in the

movement as soon as the Cultural Revolution began and stood on the side of the handful of Party persons taking the capitalist road, suppressing the revolutionaries and supporting the conservatives.

IV

The January revolutionary storm swept Canton. The revolutionary rebels were undaunted while Chu-i-ping were disunited and fragmented. Many warriors withdrew from this conservative organization. The revolutionary situation in Canton was extremely favorable. At this time, our great commander, Chairman MAO, issued the brilliant combat call to the entire army: The Liberation Army should actively support the broad masses of the left. But numerous facts prove that the Canton Military District did not follow Chairman MAO's instruction. They betrayed Chairman MAO's trust, and travelled farther and farther on the wrong road.

After the "8 February" incident of smashing Military District headquarters, the handful of persons in the Party and the army taking the capitalist road harped on and exaggerated certain deficiencies and errors of the revolutionary rebels and even resorted to the means of distortion and fabrication and imposed frantic suppression on them. Many revolutionary leftists were arrested and imprisoned. Suddenly dark clouds enshrouded Canton. When the revolutionary rebels were suffering severe political oppression and the great Cultural Revolution was suffering reversals in Canton, Chu-i-ping rose again. On 1 March, under the slogan of "helping the Liberation Army in arresting counter-revolutionaries," several thousand Chu-i-ping gathered under the command of the handful of bad leaders and wore the Chu-i-ping arm bands which they had dared not wear for a long time and marched to the Pearl River Studio and Chung-shan University. In secret coordination with the security headquarters, Chu-i-ping engaged in a battle with the Pearl River Studio Tung-fang-hung and Chung-shan University 31 August Red Guards. In this action, the morale of Chu-i-ping was high because of the "support of the Liberation Army." This action was the signal bullet announcing the revival of the long paralyzed Chu-i-ping. Upon seeing this, the handful of Party persons in Canton taking the capitalist road were overjoyed, completely supporting the criminal activities of Chu-i-ping.

At the meeting on going back to class and engaging in revolution called by Chu-i-ping on 20 March, Deputy Chief of the Municipal Military Committee FU Pen-te (4569/2609/1795) said: "Since January, your general direction has been correct. Ninety-five percent of you people have returned to Chairman MAO's revolutionary line." The handful

of Party persons in Canton taking the capitalist road fed Chu-i-ping such tranquilizers to heighten their "morale." Later, a military training corps was sent out with an ulterior motive, the political content of military training as proposed by Chairman MAO was altered, and military training was used as an important avenue of reviving Chu-i-ping.

The handful of Party persons in Canton taking the capitalist road instigated the military training corps to energetically support Chu-i-ping. Through the military training corps, they publicized: "We are military control headquarters; to oppose the military control is to oppose Chairman MAO." Thus, they further deceived Chu-i-ping, not permitting them to see the struggle between the two lines in the army and its fierce reflections in the society. On 19 April Chu-i-ping called a meeting to criticize LIU Shao-ch'i, and the command of the meeting invited "Hsueh Ch'uang Tao" (a minority faction of Chu-i-ping) of Kwangtung Tung-fang-hung schools to make a speech. The central content of the speech draft was: Chu-i-ping must be alert lest they should be used by the handful of Party persons taking the capitalist road and be made into a tool to deal with the revolutionary rebels. The draft was immediately held and not permitted to be released by FU Pen-te without any justification. Clearly, how fearful of the awakening of Chu-i-ping were the handful of persons in the Party and the army taking the capitalist road. When Chu-i-ping wanted to criticize the theory of blood relations, the handful of persons in the Party and the army not only signalled a red light, but also made the wild assertion: "It is the same thing as saying that 'heroes beget heroes and reactionaries beget reactionaries!'" "We must dissolve any organization concocted by those landlords." They connived at spreading the theory of blood relations, in order to better control Chu-i-ping and actively carried out the work of organizing them. A series of conferences establishing Chu-i-ping liaison stations were called by the Municipal Military Control Committee Deputy Chief FU Pen-te. At the conferences FU said: "The establishment of middle school Red Guard Representatives Conference is your business, not theirs (referring to the Red Flag faction)." FU Pen-te served as a bodyguard for the handful of Party persons taking the capitalist road and openly instigated Chu-i-ping to oppose Red Flag warriors. How serious is his crime! Under the single-handed planning of the handful of Party persons taking the capitalist road, the Chu-i-ping liaison station was established, and following that, the various command posts were also strengthened. Thus, Chu-i-ping were being pushed into the abyss of sin by the handful of Party persons taking the capitalist road; they engaged in rioting and looting. Chu-i-ping repeatedly attacked the revolutionary rebels. Supporting "Reversal" and singing "the Fierce March East Wind" Chu-i-ping repeatedly obstructed the great Cultural Revolution. Upon seeing these activities of Chu-i-ping, the

revolutionary rebels pointed out clearly: When you, the deceived Chu-i-ping, are shouting "opposing Liberation Army" and "the revolt of demons and devils" who does not know that you have become a propaganda organ for the handful of Party persons taking the capitalist road in suppressing the revolutionary rebels, and that they have turned you into a tool to suppress the revolutionary rebels? What Chu-i-ping did was long hoped for and immediately supported by the handful of Party persons in Canton taking the capitalist road. On 20 June when a number of Chu-i-ping were preparing to attack the "Ch'i-i" rebels of No 1 Middle School, the military training corps of the school immediately coordinated with them and stood aside, and moreover said to Chu-i-ping: "You go ahead and give them a good beating to allay our anger." Despite the repeated criticisms of Chu-i-ping by the revolutionary rebels, and despite that they were thoroughly discredited, the handful of Party persons in Canton taking the capitalist road would not shed tears until they could see the coffin, and remained determined to win a good name for Chu-i-ping. Sweet words were printed in their documents to the military training corps. Chu-i-ping were leftists, pure elements, and politically reliable, and were advancing rapidly. Under such energetic support of the handful of Party persons in Canton taking the capitalist road, Chu-i-ping, on 23 July, started a large-scale armed struggle and killed or wounded more than 400 revolutionary rebels of Red Flag Workers, Workers Alliance, Red Headquarters, and San-szu, creating the unprecedented "23 July blood incident" in Canton. At this time, the Military Control Committee paid no attention to the lives of the revolutionary rebels and, at the moment of the peak of fighting, it called to congratulate the establishment of the headquarters. The handful of persons in the Party and the army taking the capitalist road frantically opposed Chairman MAO's revolutionary line and their ugly faces were more and more exposed.

V

"Kwangtung Provincial Tung-fang-hung Schools' Chu-i-ping are rebels and it is correct for the military training corps to support the Left." Certain conspirators of the Canton Military District schemed to style themselves as models of supporting the Left. Could this be achieved? The masses cannot be deceived. Let us examine what commodity is the support of the Left on the part of Kwangtung Provincial Tung-fang-hung schools. One look will make us angry. How many of our class brothers have been harmed by the sugar-coated poison!

At the beginning of the movement, the Chu-i-ping of our school were indeed rebels; they were opposed to the school Party committee, to

the work team, to the black Provincial Committee, and to T'AO Chu, and exerted certain influences on the Cultural Revolution in Kwangtung. But there were many deficiencies. The Chu-i-ping of our school have been poisoned by the reactionary theory of blood relations. Following the great incitation of November of last year, the organization of Chu-i-ping was basically paralyzed, and many Chu-i-ping have been long separated from political struggle, and some of them have been exposed to the ideology of the Allied Action current and believed that they were of noble blood. They failed to understand the rebels when the revolution involved themselves and consequently became conservative or even dissatisfied with the Cultural Revolution and with Comrade CHIANG Ch'ing and the Central Cultural Revolution Group. This ideology was merely at a budding stage at that time, but it had its market among Chu-i-ping. If these things were allowed to spread, Chu-i-ping would inevitably go over to the opposite side.

To support and foster the young revolutionaries can never be an unprincipled moral support and acquiescence; it must start from the long-range interest of the proletarian revolution, and they must be supported with a high degree of political responsibility and MAO Tse-tung's thought. The support of them must, "make them united, progress and struggle forward with one mind while eliminating backward things and developing progressive things." The actions of our school's military training corps ran counter to Chairman MAO's instructions. It was definitely the "golden sign" for Chu-i-ping; what it publicized to Chu-i-ping was "in terms of the history of revolt, you are one generation ahead of the Chung-shan University Red Flag Red Guards." Its education for Chu-i-ping was, "Doing it in this way is profitable to you, and doing it in that way can make you famous." -- it was out-and-out use of fame and profits to corrupt Chu-i-ping. The responsible persons of the military training corps also boldly said to those students who demanded a criticism of the theory of blood relations: "Sympathy with the Allied Action is understandable, and what are you afraid of if people call you names." This is an iron fact of an open bombardment on the Central Cultural Revolution Group and opposition to Chairman MAO's revolutionary line.

A fortress is easily taken from within; the handful of persons in the Party and the army taking the capitalist road hit our school's Chu-i-ping with sugar-coated bullets. The majority of our school's Chu-i-ping forgot this instruction of Chairman MAO's: "We must never let down our guard against the frantic plots of revenge on the part of imperialist elements and their lackeys. Whoever lets down his guard will be politically disarmed and be put in a passive position." They not only failed to see the struggle between the two lines in the Canton Military District and its fierce reflections in the society but also styled themselves as "old rebels" and were very proud of it. Because of

the spreading of the reactionary theory of blood relations, Chu-i-ping regarded the Red Flag Warriors as their enemy and felt that it was not enough to trample on them, and attacked them with the big clubs of "opposing the Liberation Army", "Return to Native Place Groups," etc. They did everything in the way of beating and looting in treating the Red Flag warriors. Our school's Chu-i-ping began to oppose the revolutionary rebels and traveled onto the conservative road. At this time, the responsible person of the military training corps expressed: resolutely fight shoulder to shoulder and win victories with Chu-i-ping. On 18 April, following Premier CHOU's arrival in Canton to affirm the three Red Flag organization, member of the political committee of the military training corps KAO (7559) went as far as saying, "Why don't you think? That we now recognize as the Left and rebels those who opposed the military control and military training and resisted Chairman MAO's revolutionary line is strictly a strategic question." These people used base means and distorted the Premier's original idea in order to stabilize the "fighting will" of Chu-i-ping, thus deceiving the Premier and fooling the people. Can this be tolerated? The handful of persons in the Party and the army cannot escape blame. In June, Deputy Commander of the Kwangtung Military District LIU Hsing-lung (0491/5281/7127) came to our school and spoke to the Red Guard Committee: "The Chu-i-ping of No 6 Middle School are very brave; 20 people fought 500 in their unswerving struggle against the Chung-shan University Red Flag Red Guards." We should really praise his "firm" stand and "clear" attitude. It seemed that the determination of the Military Control Committee to oppose the revolutionary rebels was still very firm.

The military training corps three times as large as the work team has attained "great achievements." However, such "support of the Left" is difficult to understand. The last enlightenment from KAO of the military training corps was: "You are rebels. You have more attractive power than x x x (x x x has always been conservative and opposed to the organization of the revolutionary rebels). No one can lock you up, and so move ahead with courage!" So this is the case: it looks better to support former rebels engaging in conservative activities than giving support to old conservatives. This is probably the reasoning of "Even if military training in the whole province is not managed well, it is important to manage well the military training in the province's Tung-fang-hung schools."

To sum up the above, isn't it clear that certain ignorant conspirators of the military control committee wildly dreamed of using "Kwangtung Provincial Tung-fang-hung school military training corps' support of the Left" to cover up their own schemes?

The military Control Committee used, fostered and controlled Chu-i-ping.
