DEATH SENTENCE FOR SHANGHAI PARTY COMMITTEE Shanghai, Hung-wei Chan-pao, No. 16, 8 January 1967

All those who oppose Chairman Mao and his ideology are devils who would end misorably! This is an irrevocable truism that has been borne out

Among the workers they selected some organizations which they could dominate to stir up factional strife and antagonism, thus utilizing them to usurp administrative power. They also used diverse excuses to incite the workers to stop production in order to threaten, the Party Central Committee headed by Chairman Mao and sabotage the great cultural revolution.

Taking advantage of the fact that some people did not understand the cultural revolution too clearly, they incited them to rebel.
